STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO

RESOLVE, in Favor of Helen G. Pearson for Injuries Sustained as a State Employee.

Appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to Helen G. Pearson of Waldoboro for medical and hospital expenses for injuries sustained in state employment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Helen G. Pearson sustained very serious injuries in an automobile accident while she was employed as a child welfare worker in the Department of Health and Welfare. She has exhausted her workmen's compensation benefits and is faced with additional medical and hospital expenses.
