HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1545, L.D. 2001, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Bond Issue in the Amount of \$8,360,000 for the Construction and Renovation of Higher Education Facilities at the University of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the Title the figures "\$8,360,000" and inserting in place thereof the figures '\$4,300,000'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in the 6th line (5th in L.D.) by striking out the figures "\$8,360,000" and inserting in place thereof the figures '\$4,300,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 8 and inserting in place the following:

'Sec. 8. Allocations from General Fund Bond Issue.'
