HOUSE AMENDMENT "C " to H. P. 1546, L. D. 2002, Bill,  
"AN ACT Implementing the Reorganization of the Department of  
Finance and Administration."

Amend said Bill in section 11 in that part designated  
"§ 54." by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:  
'No member of the State Liquor Commission shall be eligible  
to be appointed as Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages  
for a period of 3 years after the expiration of his term of  
office.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit a member of  
the Liquor Commission from becoming the Director of the Bureau  
of Alcoholic Beverages.
