HOUSE AMENDMENT " E " to H. P. 1546, L. D. 2002, Bill, "AN ACT Implementing the Reorganization of the Department of Finance and Administration."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 7-A. R. S., T. 28, §51, amended. The first sentence of section 51 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The State Liquor Commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3-2 members to be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, to serve for 3 years and may after notice and hearing be removed for cause by the Governor and Council and the Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages within the Department of Finance and Administration, ex officio.'

The purpose of this amendment is to include the Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages within the Department of Finance and Administration, ex officio.
