HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 715, L. D. 2004, Bill, "AN ACT
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 124 the following:

'Sec. 124-A. R. S., T. 34, §757, additional. Title 34 of
the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 757,
to read as follows:

§757. Outgoing mail

All outgoing mail from inmates of the State Prison shall
not be censored by any officer or employee of the State Prison.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit the censoring
of outgoing mail from inmates of the State Prison.
