HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1549, L.D. 2008, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Laws Pertaining to the Protection and
Improvement of Air by Establishing Ambient Air Quality Standards."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§584-A." by
striking out all of subsection 5 and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'5. Hydrocarbon. Hydrocarbon concentration for any 3-hour
period at any location shall not exceed 160 micrograms per
cubic meter, except once per year.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the parenthetical
phrase in subsection 5 which refers to the hours of 6 a.m. to
9 a.m. as this is somewhat ambiguous language.
