SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1541, L. D. 2013, Bill, "AN ACT
Implementing the Reorganization of the Department of Transportation."

Amend said Bill in section 16 in that part designated "§ 4205."
by adding at the end the following:

'8. Maine Turnpike Authority.'

Further amend said Bill by adding after section 24 the following:

'Sec. 24-A. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 69, §16, amended. Section 16 of
chapter 69 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended, is
further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:


The Maine Turnpike Authority shall convey to the State of Maine any
and all right, title and interest which it has in and to any real and
personal property which property shall thereafter be under the
jurisdiction and control of the Department of Transportation. It shall
transfer or assign all moneys, accounts receivable, insurance and other
property of whatever nature in the custody and control of the authority,
however, the money and receivables together with income accruing to the
Department of Transportation, from the property and facilities
transferred, in an amount equal to the authority's indebtedness, shall
be deposited in a separate debt retirement fund for the retirement of
any indebtedness of the authority outstanding and existing at the date
of transfer. The account so created shall be drawn on in payment of
the indebtedness as it becomes due and payable.'
