HOUSE AMENDMENT "E " to H. P. 1572, L. D. 2029, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Disclosure of Economic Interests by Legislators."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 17, § 3104, amended. The first sentence of section 3104 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No trustee, superintendent, treasurer or other person holding a place of trust in any state office or public institution of the State, any member of the Legislature, or any officer of a quasi-municipal corporation shall be pecuniarily interested directly or indirectly in any contracts made in behalf of the State or of the institution or of the quasi-municipal corporation in which he holds such place of trust, and any contract made in violation hereof is void.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include legislators in conflicts of interest in dealing with contracts with the State.
