SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1572, L. D. 2029, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Disclosure of Economic Interests by Legislators."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting at the end before the  
period, the following:

'and Others'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after that part designated  
"§ 395.", the following:


'§ 396. Legislative counsel or legislative agent

On registration under section 311, a legislative counsel or agent  
shall disclose the source, but not the amount, of any income over \$1,000  
received by him for the last taxable year under the Maine Income Tax  
Law and the source and the amount of any agreement or contract over  
\$1,000 received or to be received by him for services rendered as such  
legislative counsel or agent at any regular or special session of the  
Legislature. Within 30 days after the adjournment of the Legislature,  
whether a regular or special session, such legislative counsel or agent  
shall indicate the persons who paid him more than \$1,000 for represen-  
tation before the Legislature by filing a statement with the Secretary  
of State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include legislative counsel  
or agents in the bill.
