SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1575, L.D. 2032, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a Tuition Equalization Fund for Maine Students Entering Maine Private Colleges."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the 2nd line by inserting after the words "General Fund" the following: 'to the Department of Education'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting at the end the following sentence:

'The sum appropriated shall be expended for school grants for the school year 1972-1973.'
