HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 762, L.D. 2033, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Clarifying Definitions Relating to the Potato Industry
of Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out all of the 2nd
underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'No person shall buy, solicit or negotiate the sale of any
potatoes in this State as a representative of any dealer or
broker unless such representative has been so authorized by a
duly licensed dealer or broker in writing, and a copy of such
authorization is filed with the commissioner, except where such
representative conducts business in the office of said dealer
or broker. The commissioner shall be notified in writing by said
dealer or broker immediately upon the termination of such author-
ization.'

Further amend said Bill in section 7 by striking out all of
"paragraph A" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Name and address of the receiver at the point of final
destination if requested and furnished at the time of sale;'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the legal confusion
of the original bill and to clarify a condition under which grade
may be guaranteed to destination.
