SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 762, L. D. 2033, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Clarifying Definitions Relating to the Potato Industry of Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out all of the 2nd underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'No person shall buy, solicit or negotiate the sale of any potatoes in this State as a representative of any dealer or broker unless such representative has been so authorized by a duly licensed dealer or broker in writing, and a copy of such authorization is filed with the commissioner, except where such representative conducts business in the office of said dealer or broker. The commissioner shall be notified in writing by said dealer or broker immediately upon the termination of such authorization.'

Further amend said Bill in section 7 in the 2nd paragraph by striking out all of the first underlined sentence which reads as follows: "Any agreement the effect of which is to deny the producer of his right to satisfy his guarantee obligations as aforesaid and any agreement conflicting with the provisions of this subsection are null and void."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the legal confusion of the original bill.
