HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1577, L. D. 2034, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a Forest Lands Taxation Policy Using a Productivity Approach."

Amend said Bill in section 8 in that part designated "<u>§ 578.</u>" in the 9th line of subsection 1 (_{same} in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "<u>differs from</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'is more than 10% less than'

Further amend said Bill in section 8 in that part designated "<u>§ 578.</u>" in the 10th line of subsection 1 (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and figures "by more than 10%"

Further amend said Bill in section 8 in that part designated "<u>§ 578.</u>" by inserting after the 2nd sentence of subsection 2 (same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence: '<u>If the</u> <u>April 1, 1973 total assessed valuation of forest lands for the</u> <u>entire unorganized territory is more than 10% less than the</u> <u>April 1, 1972 total assessed valuation of forest lands for the</u> <u>entire unorganized territory, the State Tax Assessor shall</u> <u>adjust the April 1, 1973 assessed values of forest lands back</u> to a 10% change.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to clarify the language in section 578 to avoid any constitutional guestion about uniform treatment.
