HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. ¹⁵⁸¹~~1544~~, L.D. ²⁰³⁸~~2000~~, Bill, "AN ACT
to Grant Adult Rights to Persons Eighteen Years of Age."

Amend said Bill in section 8 by adding at the end of that
part designated "§73.", before the period, the following:
', except that notwithstanding any other provisions of law any
person who has not attained the age of 20 years shall be deemed
a minor in any transaction including a loan from a bank or sales
finance company'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt persons who have
not attained 20 years of age from the provisions relating to
transactions involving loans from a bank or sales finance company.
