HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 767, L. D. 2045, Bill, "AN
ACT to Revise the Site Location of Development Law."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the 2nd
underlined paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'5. Subdivision. A "subdivision" is the division of a parcel of
land into 5 or more lots, any one of which is less than 10 acres in
size, if said lots make up an aggregate land area of more than 20
acres and are to be offered for sale or lease to the general public
during any 5-year period.'

Statement of Fact

It is the purpose of this amendment to define subdivisions in a
manner consistent with the way in which they are presently being
administered under the Site Location Law, and to make it clear that
subdivisions of under 20 acres are not covered by the law.
