HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in "SECTION K" by striking out in the 8th line (same in L.D.) the words and punctuation "Hotel and Motel Association, Maine Sporting Camps" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Maine Innkeepers Association'

Further amend said Bill in "SECTION K" by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'The member of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs shall be authorized to call the organizational meeting of the committee as the chairman pro tem.'

Statement of Fact

The Maine Innkeepers Association now represents the Hotel and Motel Association, the Restaurant Association and the Maine Sporting Camps. There is a need of a chairman pro tem to call the organizational meeting of the committee.
