HOUSE AMENDMENT " D" to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in "SECTION A" by inserting before that part designated "MAINE MARITIME ACADEMY" the following:

Further amend said Bill in "SECTION A" by striking out all of the last 3 lines (4 lines in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS - SECTION A \$ 1,999,794 \$ 7,609,614

Amounting to \$1,999,794 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$7,609,614 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide funds to implement chapter 379 of the public laws of 1971. The funds requested will permit the Maine Commission on Drug Abuse to effectively carry out its statutory responsibilities as defined in chapter 379 of the public laws of 1971. Initial operational funds were derived
