HOUSE AMENDMENT "H " to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in SECTION A by striking out all of the caption "University of Maine" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'UNIVERSITY OF MAINE

All Other ----- 1,015,000

Provides additional grant to University and \$15,000 to provide for salaries for interns to carry out the Internship Program.'

Further amend said Bill in SECTION A by striking out all of the last 3 lines (last 4 lines in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS - SECTION A \$1,991,294 \$7,564,614

Amounting to \$1,991,294 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$7,564,614 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.'
