HOUSE AMENDMENT "I " to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in SECTION A by striking out under the caption "MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" everything relating to "Dietary Improvement" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Dietary Improvement

All Other	-----	100,000

Provides per capita food costs of \$1 per day per institutional resident.'

Further amend said Bill in SECTION A by striking out all of the last line (last 2 lines in L. D.) under the caption "MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL MENTAL HEALTH AND CORRECTIONS	\$121,160	\$898,239'

Further amend said Bill in SECTION A by striking out all of the last 3 lines (last 4 lines in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS - SECTION A	<u>\$1,991,294</u>	<u>\$7,599,614</u>

Amounting to \$1,991,294 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$7,599,614 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.'
