HOUSE AMENDMENT "M" to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in "SECTION C" by striking out all of that part relating to "DRUG ABUSE" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'DRUG ABUSE--Grants to Local Programs \$ 50,000

Provides additional funds for grants,  
\$15,000 to carry into 1972-73 year.  
Provides \$25,000 to carry on the Maine  
Drug Education Program of the Department  
of Education.'

Further amend said Bill in "SECTION C" by striking out all of the last 4 lines (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL SECTION C \$1,777,022

Amounting to \$1,777,022 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972. Any balance at June 30, 1972 to carry into the 1973 fiscal year to be expended for the same purposes.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide \$25,000 to carry on the Maine Drug Education Program of the Department of Education.
