HOUSE AMENDMENT" O " to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in SECTION A under the caption "Health and Welfare" by striking out at the end of the paragraph relating to Nursing and Boarding Home Care the figures and period "1972-73." and inserting in place thereof the following: '1972-73, except that boarding homes and nursing homes on a temporary license shall not receive any increases in 1972-73.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that temporary boarding and nursing homes shall not receive the increase.
