HOUSE AMENDMENT " P " to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill by inserting after "SECTION L" the following:

'SECTION M

1972-73

HEALTH AND WELFARE, DEPARTMENT OF

Aid to Aged, Blind or Disabled

All Other 600,000

Provides funds to increase standards for aged, blind, or disabled under state programs. This appropriation will bring in \$1,200,000 in federal funds.

SECTION N

P. & S. L., 1971, c. 117, amended. That part of chapter 117 of the private and special laws of 1971 under SECTION A under the caption "FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION" which relates to the Bureau of Taxation is amended to read as follows:

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the appropriation in the Tax Relief for the Elderly Program in the amount of \$600,000 and transfer this same amount to Health and Welfare, Aid to the Aged, Blind or Disabled Account.
