HOUSE AMENDMENT "S " to S.P. 768, L.D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in SECTION H by striking out in the 5th line of that part designated "§2206." (same in L.D.) the underlined words "one year" and inserting in place thereof the following: '5 consecutive years'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the residency requirement for North American Indian scholarships from one year to 5 consecutive years.
