SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of State Government and Other Purposes for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in SECTION A by inserting after the caption "LABOR AND INDUSTRY, DEPARTMENT OF" the following:

'LAND USE REGULATION COMMISSION

All Other	-		27,425
Capital Expenditures			7,950

Provides funds for an Engineering Technician I and Clerk-Stenographer II because of increased jurisdiction and administrative responsibilities of the Commission.'

Further amend said Bill in SECTION A by striking out all of the last 3 lines (last 4 lines in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS - SECTION'A \$1,991,294 \$7,598,989 Amounting to \$1,991,294 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$7,598,989 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.'
