SENATE AMENDMENT "K" to S. P. 768, L. D. 2047, Bill, "AN ACT to appropriate moneys for the expenditures of state government and other purposes for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1972 and June 30, 1973."

Amend said Bill in SECTION A under the caption "Health and Welfare" by striking out at the end of the paragraph relating to Nursing and Boarding Home Care the figures and period "1972-73." and inserting in place thereof the following: '1972-73, except that boarding homes and nursing homes on a temporary license shall not receive any increases in 1972-73.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that temporary boarding and nursing homes shall not receive the increase.
