HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1592, L.D. 2050, Bill, "AN ACT  
Creating the Maine Industrial Port Authority."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§10005."  
by inserting at the end the following paragraph:

'Provided, however, that before the Legislature establishes  
the territorial limits of the authority it shall order a referendum  
of the residents of the area within reasonable proximity to the  
recommended location, and whose property or locations might  
reasonably be deemed affected by the location, in order to ascertain  
their opinion on the proposed location.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes a local option referendum election  
in the area of the proposed Port Authority. The Legislature shall  
set the limits of this referendum.
