**AN ACT Reclassifying Part of the Waters of Presumpscot River,
Cumberland County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 368, amended. That part of section 368 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes which is captioned "Presumpscot River Basin," as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 7-A, to read as follows:

7-A. Presumpscot River, main stem, from the outlet of Sebago Lake to the dam at Dundee — Class A.
