HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to Joint Senate Order (S.P. 626)
relative to establishment of a special committee on legislative
rules and procedures.

Amend said Order in the 4th paragraph by striking out in
the 3rd and 4th lines the words and punctuation "now, therefore
be it" and inserting in place thereof the word 'and'

Further amend said Order by inserting after the 4th paragraph
the following paragraph:

'WHEREAS, the Legislative Research Committee has the duty
of assisting the Legislature concerning such legislative problems
under the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 163,
subsection 4; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Order by striking out all of the 5th, 6th,
7th and 8th paragraphs.

Further amend said Order in the 9th paragraph by striking out
in the first line the words "The committee" and inserting in place
thereof the words and punctuation 'ORDERED, the House concurring,
that the Legislative Research Committee'

Further amend said Order by striking out all of the last
paragraph.
