HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to Joint Senate Order (S.P. 655)
relating to telephone service for the Legislature.

Amend said Order by striking out everything after the word and punctuation "concurring," in the first line, and inserting in place thereof the following: 'that free telephone service may be provided after final adjournment of the Legislature, during the remainder of the biennium, for each member of the Senate and House to the number of fifty calls of reasonable duration, from a point within the limits of the State of Maine to any point within the State of Maine, the privilege granted to be a personal privilege, not to be exercised by other than the member, and that each member of the Senate and House may be provided with a credit card under the direction of the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House, the cost of this service to be paid to the New England Telephone Company at regular tariff rates. The executive officer of the Legislature is authorized to install and supervise a measured in-watts system for members of the Legislature for calling to Augusta to communicate with state departments within the Capitol complex.'
