SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 757, JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO CALL A CONVENTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION TO PERMIT VOLUNTARY PRAYER IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Amend said Joint Resolution in the Title by striking out the capitalized words "TO CALL A CONVENTION"

Further amend said Joint Resolution by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'WHEREAS, constitutional silence on prayer in the public school system has given way to widespread confusion and concern among the people of Maine; and

WHEREAS, the Congress is empowered under Article V to propose amendments to the Constitution of the United States whenever two-thirds of both Houses shall deem it necessary; and

WHEREAS, the people of Maine, through appropriate action, have deemed it essential for the preservation of public peace that the Congress propose an amendment to the Constitution providing for voluntary prayer in the public schools; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Joint Resolution in the 4th paragraph by striking out in the 3rd line the words "make application" and inserting in place thereof the words ' urge and recommend'

Further amend said Joint Resolution in the 4th paragraph by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines the words "to call a convention" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'that action be taken'

Further amend said Joint Resolution in the 5th paragraph by striking out in the 3rd line the words "for a convention"
