HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to House Rule 49-A.

Amend said Order by striking out all of that part designated "49-A" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'49-A. Any bill or resolve which bears a unanimous Ought to Pass report by the committee to which it has been referred, upon notification to the House, shall, without further action, be placed by the Clerk upon the special consent calendar and remain there for two legislative days; it shall, at the termination of the said two days, be considered as passed to be engrossed. Upon objection of any member to the placement or retention of any bill or resolve on the consent calendar, such bill or resolve shall cease to be a consent calendar bill. If a bill or resolve is taken from the special consent calendar, the first order of business with respect to it shall be whether to accept the committee report.'
