COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 5, L.D. 5, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to the Control of Dogs.

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 3455" by striking  
out all of the last underlined paragraph and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'"At large" means off the premises of the owner and not under  
the control of any person by means of personal presence and  
attention as will reasonably control the conduct of such dog.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete control of dogs  
by means of a leash.
