HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 5, L. D. 5, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to the Control of Dogs."

Amend said bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said bill by inserting at the end before
the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 7, § 3601, repealed. Section 3601 of
Title 7 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is repealed.'
