AN ACT Limiting the Number of Lobster Traps Per Person.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 4467, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4467 to read as follows:

§ 4467. Number of traps

It is unlawful for any person to set more than 600 lobster traps per boat at any one time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the number of lobster traps per person to 600.
