HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 9, L. D. 9, RESOLUTION, Proposing  
an Amendment to the Constitution Reducing Residence Requirement  
for Voting to Thirty Days.

Amend said Resolution by striking out in the Title the word  
"Thirty" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Fifteen'

Further amend said Resolution in the 2nd paragraph by striking  
out in the 8th, 11th and 14th lines (6th, 9th and 11th lines in L. D.)  
the underlined word "thirty" and inserting in place thereof the  
underlined word 'fifteen'

Further amend said Resolution by striking out in the last  
line of the 3rd paragraph from the end, before the Statement of  
Fact, (same in L. D.) the word "thirty" and inserting in place  
thereof the word 'fifteen'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce residence requirement  
for voting to fifteen days instead of thirty days.
