## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Fingerprinting of School Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 1548, amended. Section 1548 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

This section shall not apply if the parent or guardian of a child shall present a signed statement to the State Bureau of Identification that such parent or guardian is opposed to the fingerprinting of such child.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit a parent or guardian to oppose the fingerprinting of his school child in which case the fingerprinting will not be done.
