HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 21, L. D. 21, Bill, "AN ACT Exempting Clothing from the Sales Tax."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line (5th line in L. D.) the underlined figure "\$175" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$50'

## Fiscal Note

It is estimated that there will be a loss of revenue in the amount of \$8,925,000 for a full year.

## Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to lower the exemption from \$175 to \$50 so that persons buying working clothes, etc. will be included in the exemption.
