HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 21, L. D. 21, Bill, "AN ACT  
Exempting Clothing from the Sales Tax."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line (5th line  
in L. D.) the underlined figure "\$175" and inserting in place  
thereof the underlined figure '\$50'

Fiscal Note

It is estimated that there will be a loss of revenue  
in the amount of \$8,925,000 for a full year.

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to lower the exemption  
from \$175 to \$50 so that persons buying working clothes, etc.  
will be included in the exemption.
