**AN ACT Restricting Power Boats on Haley Pond, Franklin County.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 38, § 240, amended.** Section 240 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 49 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

**No person shall operate any boat or canoe propelled by motor on Haley Pond in the Town of Rangeley, Franklin County.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

Haley Pond is a small shallow pond located within the built-up portion of the Town of Rangeley. There has been an objection that boats propelled by motor have upset nesting water fowl. This pond is adjacent to the Rangeley Game Sanctuary.
