STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on Beaver Mountain Pond,
Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 240, amended. Section 240 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 49 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1971, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

No person shall operate any boat or canoe propelled by a motor in excess of 40 horse power on Beaver Mountain Pond (Long Pond) in Sandy River Plantation, Franklin County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

A majority of camp owners on this pond have by petition indicated that boats in excess of 40 horse power have become a public nuisance on this small pond by endangering persons using smaller boats for fishing or relaxation and in instances have endangered young children in bathing areas.
