Amend said Bill in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) by inserting after the words "70 years of age" the following underlined words: 'and who has been a resident of the State for 5 years or more and held a Maine hunting license for the previous year'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require as a prerequisite to obtaining a Maine hunting license at least 5 years of residence in the State and a license the previous year.
