HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 1, L.D. 28, Bill, "AN ACT
Providing Complimentary Hunting Licenses to Maine Residents over
70 years of Age."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) by
inserting after the words "70 years of age" the following
underlined words: 'and who has been a resident of the State
for 5 years or more and held a Maine hunting license for the
previous year'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require as a prerequisite
to obtaining a Maine hunting license at least 5 years of residence
in the State and a license the previous year.
