IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Aviation Oil Company for Tax Paid for Shrinkage of Motor Fuel.

Aviation Oil Company; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$2,177.95 from the General Highway Fund to Aviation Oil Company of Waterville in settlement of its claim against the State for refund for tax paid on account of shrinkage or loss by evaporation of motor fuel.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 2906, any retail dealer is entitled to a refund for tax paid on account of shrinkage or loss by evaporation of motor fuel. The refunds shall be made semiannually within 90 days after June 30th and December 31st. Aviation Oil Company did not file for a refund for the period July 1, 1971 to December 31, 1971 within the statutory time limit.
