AN ACT Authorizing Use of the Name Friends of Maine Medical Center.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Use of the name Friends of Maine Medical Center; authorized. The Friends of Maine Medical Center, which will be incorporated as a nonprofit, charitable corporation, is granted the authority to use the name "Friends of Maine Medical Center" as its corporate name.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would permit the Friends of Maine Medical Center, an auxiliary group at the Maine Medical Center at Portland, to utilize the word "Maine" as part of their name when the auxiliary incorporates.
