COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 32, L. D. 39, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing an Open Season on Moose."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 16th and 17th lines

(14th and 15th in L. D.) the underlined words, figures and punctuation "Interstate 95; then northerly along Interstate 95 to the Canadian border at Houlton." and inserting in place thereof the following ' the Canadian border at Vanceboro.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 19th line (17th line in L. D.) the underlined figure "500" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '250'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of the 10th paragraph from the end, before the Statement of Fact, which reads as follows:

"The fee for such application shall be \$1 which shall not be refunded."

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th paragraph from the end, before the Statement of Fact, all of the 2nd underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The commissioner is authorized to divide the designated area open to moose hunting into zones and to designate the number of permits to be issued for each zone, not to exceed 250 permits in 1973 and 500 permits for 1974.'
