COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 42, L.D.49, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Assistance to Blind Persons in Marking Absentee Ballots."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'7. Blindness. A voter who is blind may obtain assistance
in marking his ballot from 2 persons, not of the same political
faith, but may be of the same political faith at primary elections,
or father, mother, brother, sister, husband, wife or child as he
may select, providing that said aides are of voting age.'
