**AN ACT Relating to Removal or Destruction of Landmark Boundaries by
State Departments.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 7554-A, additional. Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 7554-A to read as follows:

§ 7554-A. Removal or destruction of landmark boundaries by state departments

Any state department or agency which removes or destroys any landmark boundary, whether public or private, shall reestablish such boundary.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require any state department which removes or destroys a landmark boundary to immediately restore such boundary.
