## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Removal or Destruction of Landmark Boundaries by State Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 14, § 7554-A, additional. Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 7554-A to read as follows:
- § 7554-A. Removal or destruction of landmark boundaries by state departments

Any state department or agency which removes or destroys any landmark boundary, whether public or private, shall reestablish such boundary.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require any state department which removes or destroys a landmark boundary to immediately restore such boundary.
