COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 48, L.D. 55, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to State Police Retirement System."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd and 4th lines  
after the amending clause (3rd line of L.D.) the following  
underlined words: "upon attainment of age 55" and inserting in  
place thereof the following underlined words and punctuation:  
'no later than July 1, 1974'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 10th line  
after the amending clause (8th and 9th lines of L.D.) the following  
underlined words "attained age 55" and inserting in place thereof  
the following underlined words and punctuation: 'July 1, 1974'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment, if enacted, to provide  
mandatory retirement no later than July 1, 1974 for those  
members of the State Police employed on or before July 9, 1943  
who are currently exempted from both the mandatory retirement  
age of 70, applicable to the vast majority of state employees  
and the mandatory retirement age of 55, applicable to the majority  
of state police officers.
