COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 50, L.D. 57, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to the Wearing of Fluorescent Orange Clothing While  
Hunting During Hunting Season."

Amend said Bill by striking everything out after the amending  
clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'§ 2468. Fluorescent clothing

Any person while hunting with firearms during the open  
firearm season on deer, except when hunting waterfowl from a  
boat or blind or in conjunction with waterfowl decoys, shall  
wear hunter fluorescent orange clothing which is in good and  
serviceable condition and which shall be visible from all sides.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the safety of  
hunters.
